VETERANS' JOB OPPORTUNITIES TASK FORCE

This Order creates the Veterans' Job Opportunities Task Force.

The Task Force will include representatives from business and manufacturing, organized labor, veterans organizations, municipalities, education and economic development specialists.

The purpose of the Task Force is to suggest and help create programs and activities designated to expand the job opportunities available to Maine's returning veterans.

By May 1, 1971, the Task Force is requested to submit to the Governor a written report of its findings with proposals intended to ease the entry of Maine's returning veterans into our work force and general society.

The Task Force shall have the necessary authority to carry out the purpose of this Order and will hold public hearings. Staff assistance will be provided by the Maine Employment Security Commission. All State agencies are directed to cooperate fully in carrying out this review.

Chairman of the Task Force will be Robert Washburn, Commissioner of Veterans' Services. The members of the Task Force shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties under this Executive Order.
