SUBJECT: Extension of Time in Reference to Executive Order #24,
Code of Fair Practices and Affirmative Action

The amount of time necessary to prepare an effective Affirmative Action Plan for each of the state agencies seems to be somewhat more than was initially expected.

Further, the Equal Opportunity Officer for the Department of Personnel, who is to write the Statewide Plan as well as act as a consultant to the Equal Opportunity Officers in all other state agencies, did not join the staff until July 29, 1974.

Therefore, an extension will be granted from September 1, 1974 to October 15, 1974 in order that all agencies have additional time to have their written plans reviewed and commented on before the final copies are submitted to the Human Rights Commission and the Department of Personnel.
