
TO: ALL AGENCY AND DEPARTMENT HEADS

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Civil Defense is the coordinating agency for State Government in time of emergency.

WHEREAS, due to the nature of its mission, it is necessary that the Bureau's staff be supplemented by official representatives of each State Agency and Department.

I, THEREFORE, direct that all State Agency and Department heads submit to the Director, Bureau of Civil Defense, when requested by him, the names of their official representatives.

The representatives named shall have the qualifications desired by the Bureau in its request.
