PREPARATION FOR THE 106TH LEGISLATURE

Planning has begun for the 106th Legislature which is constitutionally set for January 3, 1973. As part of this process, all Department and Agency Heads shall submit to me by October 13, 1972 all legislative proposals they wish to have considered at the regular session. Earlier submissions are encouraged.

All proposals shall be in memoranda clearly designated Legislative Session Proposals. An original and four (4) copies of all memoranda should be forwarded.

Initial receipt of these memoranda will be briefly acknowledged. Later, members of the Governor's staff and representatives of the Department of Finance and Administration will discuss proposals with the Department and Agency Heads.
