WHEREAS, the Governor feels that these state employees and volunteers should be given special recognition for their extra efforts on behalf of the people of Maine;



AWARDS COMMITTEE

There is hereby created an Awards Committee which shall consist of the following members:

- The President of the Maine State Employees Association (Chairperson)
- The Chairperson of the Governor's Positive Action Committee
- The Commissioner of Finance and Administration
- The State Budget Officer

The Committee shall assist the Governor in locating state employees and volunteers who have made outstanding contributions to State Government. In addition to recommending to the Governor persons who should receive a Distinguished Service Award, the Awards Committee also shall explore additional ways in which state employees can be rewarded for their extra efforts.
