Subject EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 10 FY '74-'75 (Section 1.3)

In Executive Order No. 10, I have been designated as the approving authority for design of identification other than the Department registration plates for use on state vehicles.

In order to avoid the possible proliferation of designs for each agency, I am attaching a design which will be the only approved decal for state vehicles. The attached decal, as you can see, is from the Department of Transportation. The name of your specific Department can be substituted for the word "Transportation."

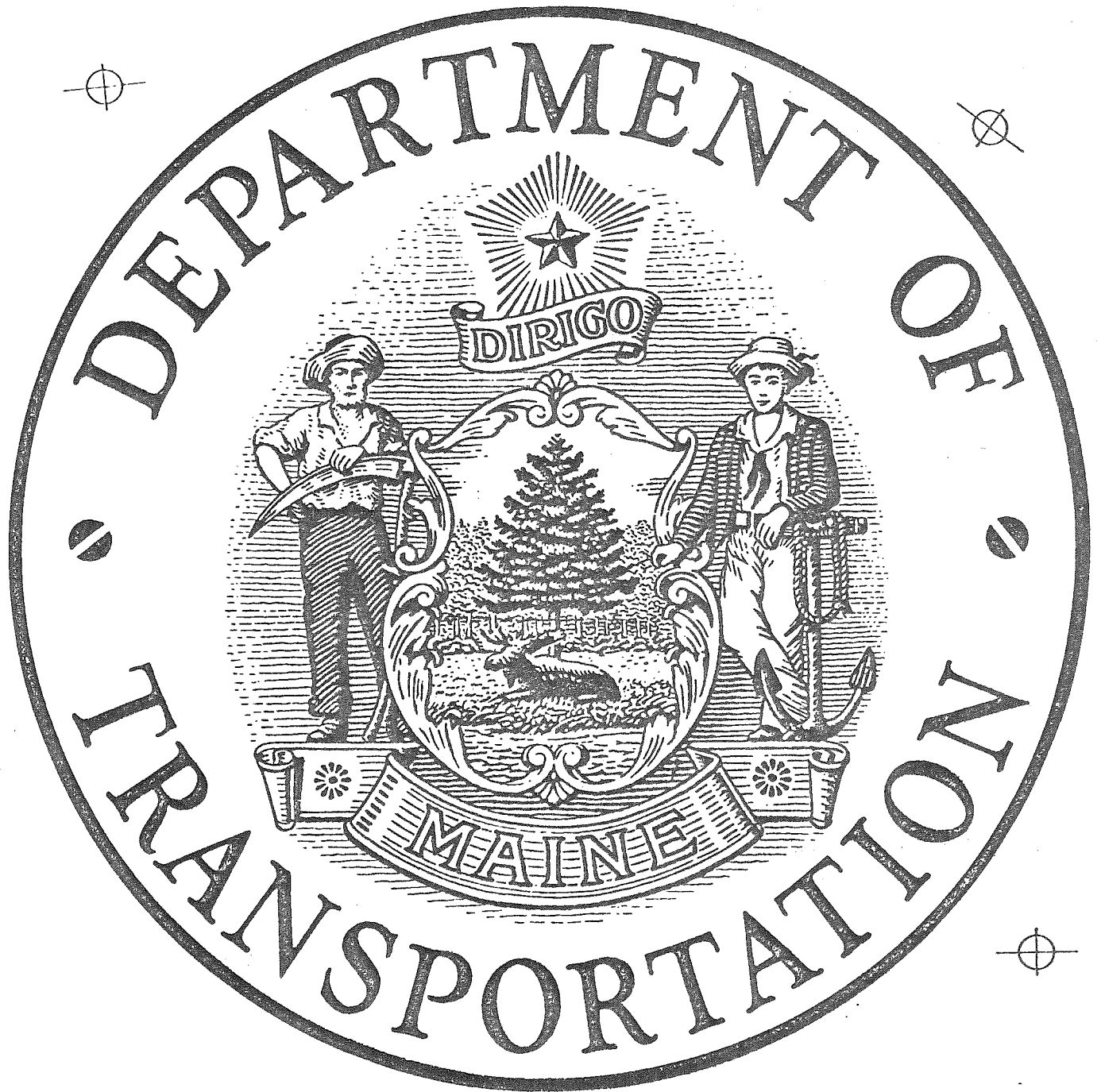
In order to facilitate the pooling of vehicles within an agency, separate bureaus within the agency will not be allowed a separate design. They will have to use the department identification mark.

Again, this policy is not intended to suppress creativity or individuality in decal design, but rather an effort to provide some uniformity for state vehicles.
