Subject Executive Order No. 10 FY'74-'75

Pursuant to a recommendation of the Department of State, the policies and procedures attached to and incorporated by reference into Executive Order No. 10 FY '74 - '75, "Policy and Procedures on the Use of State Owned Vehicles," is hereby amended as follows:

"IDENTIFICATION.

§ 1.3. The use of further identification, such as decals, is at the discretion of each department and agency. Any such identification must be approved by the Secretary-of-State Governor."

STATEMENT OF FACT

The above language provides that the authority for the approval of identification of decals on state-owned vehicles is now vested in the Governor.
