PREPARATION FOR 109TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

WHEREAS, the 109th Maine Legislature will meet in Regular Session to consider the biennial budget, as well as other essential statutory changes requiring legislative action, and,

WHEREAS, the Maine Constitution requires the Governor to recommend to the Legislature a program of legislation, and

WHEREAS, Joint Rules of the Maine Legislature establish a deadline for departmental submission of legislation to the Office of Legislative Research for a newly elected Governor 30 days from his oath taking, and

WHEREAS, it is the express policy of this Governor and administration to provide all possible assistance in effecting a smooth transition for the next Governor and his staff,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAMES B. LONGLEY, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby direct all departments and agencies to submit all statutory requests on or before October 15, 1978 to Joseph Hochadel, Office of the Governor, for presentation to the Governor-elect for his consideration.

Forms for submission of legislative proposals are attached. If any proposals have budgetary implications, please provide the Budget Office with a copy of the form. If you need any general information, please contact Susan Haden, Office of the Governor, 289-3138.
