AN ORDER AMENDING THE SYSTEM OF PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED AND AMENDED

WHEREAS, it is the policy of this administration to encourage the development of a planning and development system in which Federal, State and local interests work together in proper planning for and development of the State as authorized by existing provisions of the law; and

WHEREAS, the Act Relating to Regional Planning and the Establishment of Regional Councils of Governments, as amended, as codified in M.R.S.A., Title 30, Sections 4521-23, authorizes the Governor to designate regional planning and development districts; and

WHEREAS, a system of planning and development districts was established by Executive Order dated January 16, 1972 and amended by Executive Orders dated December 10, 1974 and May 19, 1980; and

WHEREAS, within the Kennebec Planning and Development District there are two well-established and active regional planning commissions which have attempted, but have been unable, to form an effective merger; and

WHEREAS, with changes in federal and state programs, two separate districts whould better serve local and state interests in economic development planning;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH E. BRENNAN, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby order and direct:

- That those municipalities and unorganized territories served by the North Kennebec Regional Planning Commission be designated as the North Kennebec Planning and Development District.
- 2. That those municipalities served by the Southern Kennebec Valley Regional Planning Commission be designated as the South Kennebec Planning and Development District.
