Subject Lifting of Restrictions Implemented by Executive Order #13 FY 82/83 - May 9, 1983

I am pleased to inform you that due to improvements in the State's General Fund Undedicated revenue collections for this fiscal year I am rescinding those restrictions on the filling of vacant positions, out-of-state travel, and the purchase of capital equipment which were specified earlier.

However, I do urge the exercise of prudent restraint with regard to any expenditures in these and other areas so that we can avoid the reinstatement of supplementary expenditure control procedures.

Naturally all ongoing review/approval processes such as those relating to personnel actions, out-of-state travel beyond the 700 mile limit and motor vehicle acquisitions/replacements will remain in place.
