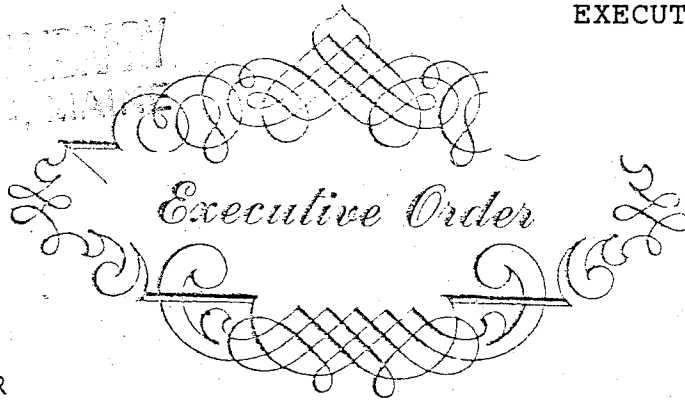

EXTENSION OF SPECIAL BUDGET AND EXPENDITURE ORDER OF 1983


WHEREAS, General Fund undedicated revenues for the month of June did not meet anticipated levels; and

WHEREAS, the State finished FY 1983 with only a very modest General Fund surplus; and

WHEREAS, it is not possible to predict with certainty when revenue collections will increase to anticipated levels; and

WHEREAS, there remains a continuing need to restrict expenditures to match revenues;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH E. BRENNAN, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby order and direct that Executive Order 13FY82/83, titled Special Budget and Expenditure Order of 1983, will remain in effect through September 15, 1983, unless specifically amended, terminated or further extended by executive order.
