DATE October 4, 1985Change to Standard Pay Schedule
for Certain Warden Service Employees

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 15FY 84/85, issued June 11, 1985, decreed that all non-standard employees governed by that Order would continue to be paid their base salary plus the non-standard premium until otherwise ordered or changed by agreement with the representative bargaining agent; and

WHEREAS, since that Order was issued, the Warden Service has experienced significant difficulty in maintaining adequate law enforcement coverage because of the continuation of non-standard scheduling; and


WHEREAS, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will place Game Wardens and Game Warden Specialists on a standard rotating shift schedule, effective October 6, 1985, to better ensure adequate law enforcement coverage; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Personnel has determined that, upon implementation of the standardized work schedule, Game Wardens and Game Warden Specialists would no longer be eligible for designation as non-standard employees; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife has duly notified the representative bargaining agent and proceeded with impact negotiations over this work schedule change as required by the applicable collective bargaining agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH E. BRENNAN, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby issue the following Order, effective Sunday, October 6, 1985:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Executive Order No. 15FY 84/85, Game Wardens and Game Warden Specialists shall be taken off the non-standard pay schedule and placed on the appropriate standard pay schedule at the appropriate range and step as soon as they are no longer eligible for designation as non-standard employees as determined by the Department of Personnel.
