EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 16 FY 86/87 Page 6

Following the initial appointments, the Governor may appoint members to additional three-year terms. Members shall serve until a successor is appointed. Selection shall be in a manner consistent with that of the original appointment.

Committee Structure

Such standing and ad hoc committees as are necessary to the performance of this Order may be formed by the Council.

Committees may include subject matter experts who are not members of the Council.

Meetings

The Council shall meet at such times and such places as it deems necessary. The meetings shall be publicly announced and open to the general public.

A majority of members of the Council shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Administration

The Maine Department of Labor shall be the fiscal agent for the State as required under Public Law 97-300, and shall be the fiscal agent for the Council. Pursuant to his authority under 26 M.R.S.A. §1401, the Commissioner of the Department of Labor may appoint such employees as he deems necessary to carry out the purpose of this Order.

The Commissioner of the Department of Labor is authorized to promulgate regulations, in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, 5 M.R.S.A. §8002 <u>et seq</u>., as may be necessary to carry out the State's responsibilities under this Order.

The Council shall establish by-laws for its governance. Such by-laws shall be subject to the Governor's approval.

The Council shall replace the Maine Job Training Council on or before July 1, 1987, at which time Executive Order 9 FY 82/83 is hereby rescinded.
