AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER 11 FY 90/91

WHEREAS, Executive Order 11 FY 90/91, dated February 13, 1991, provided that all State employees will be laid off without pay for a total of three (3) workdays prior to June 1, 1991; and


WHEREAS, on February 15, 1991, an Agreement was entered into between the Executive Branch of the State of Maine (hereinafter State) and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 93 (hereinafter AFSCME), which provides for specific procedures, times and other circumstances for temporary layoffs of employees occupying positions in the Institutional Services bargaining unit; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Executive Order 11 FY 90/91 in order to implement the Agreement of February 15, 1991, between the State and AFSCME.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN R. MCKERNAN, JR., Governor of the State of Maine do hereby order the following:

That Executive Order 11 FY 90/91 be and the same hereby is amended to the effect that Institutional Services bargaining unit employees are, by June 1, 1991, to have three days of temporary layoffs in accordance with the terms of an Agreement between the State and AFSCME dated February 15, 1991.

This Order is effective immediately and will remain in effect through June 30, 1991, unless specifically amended, terminated, or extended by Executive Order.
