**AN ORDER AMENDING THE ORDER CREATING THE MAINE TASK FORCE
ON ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE OPERATION**

WHEREAS, the Task Force on All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) Operation created pursuant to Executive Order 18 FY 02/03 (dated 29 May 2003) is intended to incorporate a variety of perspectives to inform the conversation about the issues with respect to ATV operation that the Task Force will address; and

WHEREAS, the composition of the Task Force does not include a perspective from municipal stakeholders:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Governor John E. Baldacci, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby modify Executive Order 18 FY 02/03 in the following manner:


By amending the section entitled "Organization of the Task Force" so that the first sentence of the first paragraph of that section will read now as follows:

The Task Force shall be composed of thirteen (13) members, who will be appointed by, and serve at the pleasure of, the Governor.

By amending the list of agencies and organizations represented on the Task Force by adding a thirteenth (13th) organization, to wit: the Maine Municipal Association.

Effective Date

The effective date of this Executive Order is 12 June 2003.
