**AN ORDER AMENDING THE ORDER ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE  
TO PLAN FOR HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE KENNEBEC VALLEY**

**WHEREAS**, the Task Force to Plan for Higher Education in the Kennebec Valley created pursuant to Executive Order 38 FY 04/05 (dated 20 April 2005) was created as a forum for communication and coordination of higher education opportunity options for the Kennebec Valley; and

**WHEREAS**, the intent was to create a diverse Task Force to incorporate all points of view in order to achieve the goals of access, affordability, and quality without duplication of services:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I John E. Baldacci, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby modify Executive Order 38 FY 04/05 in the following manner:

*By amending the Membership as follows:*

*The Task Force is composed of at least ten (10) members:*


*g) Appointed by the Governor:*

- 1) A member of the faculty at the University of Maine at Augusta;*
- 2) A member of the Augusta business community;*
- 3) A member of the Augusta city council;*
- 4) A member of the University of Maine at Augusta Board of Visitors;*
- 5) A student at the University of Maine at Augusta; and*
- 6) A representative of the University College of Bangor.*

In all other respects, the terms of Executive Order 38 FY 04/05 remain the same.
