**AN ORDER AMENDING THE AMENDMENT TO THE ORDER  
TO ADVANCE MAINE'S CREATIVE ECONOMY**

**WHEREAS**, the Maine Creative Economy Council created pursuant to Executive Order 30 FY 04/05 (dated January 25, 2005) and amended by Executive Order 35 FY 04/05 (dated March 29, 2005) is intended to incorporate a broad range of innovative ideas to advance public and private initiatives; and

**WHEREAS**, a geographically diverse Council is essential to advance Maine's Creative Economy; and

**WHEREAS**, innovative and creative individuals who would otherwise make significant contributions to the Council may be unable to serve due to the costs associated with participation:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I John E. Baldacci, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby modify Executive Order 35 FY 04/05 in the following manner:


*By amending* the second sentence of the last paragraph of Section I, Membership as follows:

*Members shall serve without compensation; however, the Department of Economic and Community Development may reimburse a member's travel expenses if the member travels 250 miles or more.*

In all other respects, the terms of Executive Orders 35 FY 04/05 and 30 FY 04/05 remain the same.
