**AN ORDER TO AMEND THE EXECUTIVE ORDER ESTABLISHING THE
OFFICE OF THE STATE COORDINATOR FOR HEALTH INFORMATION
TECHNOLOGY AND THE HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
EXECUTIVE STEERING COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, effective coordination throughout state government and the private sector is important in implementing the goals of the Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health Act (HITECH Act); and

WHEREAS, it is critical there be broad representation on the Health Information Technology Steering Committee (HITSC); and

WHEREAS, including a representative of Maine's racial and ethnic minority communities and an individual with expertise in health policy or health law would provide important perspectives to the work implementing the HITECH Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John E. Baldacci, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby amend Executive Order 09 FY 10/11 as follows:

By amending the Health Information Technology Steering Committee Membership and Support section to include the following additional seats:

- An individual representing the State's racial and ethnic minority communities
- An individual with expertise in health law or health policy

In all other respects, the terms of Executive Order 10 FY 10/11 remain the same.
