AN ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 41 FY 19/20

WHEREAS, I proclaimed a state of emergency on March 15, 2020 and renewed states of emergency on April 14, 2020 and May 13, 2020 to authorize the use of emergency powers in order to expand and expedite the State's response to the serious health and safety risks of the highly contagious COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2020 I issued Executive Order 41 FY 19/20 (hereafter Executive Order 41) that, for the reasons and upon the authorities stated therein, adjusted certain matters regulated by the Department of Inland Fish & Wildlife; and

WHEREAS, it is now desirable to update and amend that Order in order to safely allow certain fishing derbies;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Janet T. Mills, Governor of the State of Maine, pursuant to 37-B M.R.S. Ch. 13, including but not limited to the authorities cited in Executive Order 41, do hereby Order as follows:

I. ORDER

Sections I (H) and (I) of Executive Order 41 are repealed. All other provisions of Executive Order 41 remain in effect.

II. EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date of this Order is May 26, 2020.
