### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Pension for Almon Wentworth of Palermo.

Almon Wentworth; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be granted to Almon Wentworth, of Palermo, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1961 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Wentworth is crippled with arthritis which affects all of his joints. He is totally disabled, bedridden and chairbound most of the time. This condition has existed for many years.
