AN ACT Permitting Archery Licensees to Hunt During the Regular Season.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 109, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 109 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'If a person does not take a deer with a bow and arrow during the special season provided in section 108, he is not precluded from ~~obtaining a~~ hunting license for ~~for~~ during the regular open season ~~with either bow and arrow, or gun, and may do so without any additional license fee.~~'
