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**AN ACT Relating to Definition of Indecent Liberties.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 134, § 6, amended.** Section 6 of chapter 134 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 6. Indecent liberties.** Whoever, being 21 years or more of age, takes any indecent liberty or liberties or indulges in any indecent or immoral practice or practices with the sexual parts or organs of any other person, male or female, under the age of 16 years, either with or without the consent of such male or female person, **or, whoever, being 21 years or more of age, induces, procures or permits any person, male or female, under the age of 16 years to indulge in immoral, sexual or indecent practices with himself, herself or any person,** shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment at hard labor for not less than one year nor more than 10 years.'
