### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Perry W. Judkins of Mechanic Falls for Sick Leave Pay.

**Perry W. Judkins; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the Forestry Department the sum of \$780 to be paid to Perry W. Judkins of Mechanic Falls as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for sick leave pay.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Judkins was employed 10 years by the State Forestry Department as a seasonal warden. He was unable to return to work in the spring of 1959 because of illness. Mr. Judkins had 52 days of sick leave pay and applied therefor. He was unable to receive it because at the time he was not a state employee.
