RESOLVE, in Favor of David A. Hickland of Milbridge.

David A. Hickland; compensated. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$175 to be paid to David A. Hickland, of Milbridge, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to his sewer line caused by the construction of the highway through the Town of Milbridge in 1956.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1956, the State Highway Commission constructed a highway through the Town of Milbridge, causing damage in the amount of \$175 to Mr. Hickland's sewer line. Mr. Hickland has never been compensated for this damage.
