SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 13, L. D. 32, Bill, "An Act Relating to Certain Standards for Nursing Homes."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in place thereof the following title: 'An Act Relating to Exit Facilities in Boarding and Nursing Homes.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Such regulations shall not apply:

A. To boarding or lodging homes having 5 or less boarders.

B. To previously licensed nursing homes having 5 or less patients.

After June 1, 1961 such regulations shall apply to any newly licensed nursing home having more than one patient, other than relatives of the owner or owners.'
