STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Permitting Certain Corporations to Hold Stockholders Meetings
Outside the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 53, § 23, amended. The last sentence of section 23 of chapter 53 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 142 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'Public utility corporations organized under the laws of this State but doing business wholly outside the limits of this Corporations not charged with the performance of any public duty within the State may provide by their by-laws for the holding of meetings of their stockholders outside the State.'
