**AN ACT Relating to Seine or Bag Net of Bait Dealers Under Fish and Game
Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 63, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 63 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'All persons dealing in live bait shall be licensed to do so by the commissioner, and the fee therefor shall be \$5 for each calendar year. The license shall authorize the person holding the same to use the ordinary commercial type minnow seine **or bag net** not to exceed ~~4~~ **8** feet in depth by ~~25~~ **150** feet in length, in the taking of minnows and other unprotected fish commonly used for bait purposes.'
