HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 32, L. D. 57, Bill, "AN  
ACT Relating to Prohibited Implements in Hunting  
Wild Birds or Animals."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of  
the first line the underlined abbreviation and number  
'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill in the 4th line by indicat-  
ing the striking out of the word and punctuation "trap,"  
by drawing a line through said word and punctuation as  
follows: '~~trap,~~'

Further amend said Bill by adding a new section 2,  
to read as follows:

"Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, §86, amended. Section 86  
of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is  
amended by adding after the first sentence a new sen-  
tence to read as follows: 'No person shall trap for  
any wild animal except fur-bearing animals in open  
season and unprotected animals.'"
