AN ACT Relating to Prohibited Implements in Hunting Wild Birds or Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 86, amended. The first sentence of section 86 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'No person shall hunt with a net, trap, crossbow, snare or contrivance other than the usual method of shooting with a firearm not larger than number 10-gauge or by shooting with a long bow and arrow, any **wild** bird or animal ~~of any species protected by law.~~'
