## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Renewal of Licenses for Retail Sale of Malt Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 32-A, additional. Chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section 32-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 32-A. Renewal licenses. Renewal licenses for sale and distribution of malt liquor in retail stores shall be issued by the Liquor Commission only after the approval of the municipal officers, or in case of unincorporated places the county commissioners, in the same manner as provided in section 24 for original licenses.'
