## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Exempting Non-Profit and Charitable Institutions from Sales and Use Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 10, sub-§ XVI, amended. The first sentence of subsection XVI of section 10 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sales to incorporated hospitals, incorporated nonprofit, charitable institutions, institutions incorporated as nonprofit corporations for the sole purpose of conducting medical research, schools, homes for the aged and regularly organized churches or houses of religious worship, excepting sales, storage or use in activities which are mainly commercial enterprises.'
