RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Rockabema Lake, Aroostook County.

Fishing regulated in Rockabema Lake. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting the use of live fish for bait and establishing in the aggregate a 5 trout and salmon daily bag limit in Rockabema Lake, Moro Plantation, Aroostook County.
