RESOLVE, in Favor of Lyndon O. Goodell of Hampden.

Lyndon O. Goodell; compensated. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,500 to be paid to Lyndon O. Goodell, of Hampden, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to a well on his property caused by blasting on a state reconstruction project on route 9 in Hampden.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Goodell's well was damaged by blasting by the State Highway Commission in connection with reconstruction on route 9 in Hampden, making it necessary for him to dig a new well to provide fit water for domestic use on his property. It is felt that he should be compensated for this loss.
