**RESOLVE, in Favor of Harold E. Carson of Hartland.**

**Harold E. Carson; credit for one year of teaching. Resolved:** That Harold E. Carson, of Hartland, be given credit for one year of teaching rendered as principal of Wheelers Field Dependents High School, Wheelers Field, Tripoli, Libya, to be applied toward meeting requirements for a retirement benefit under the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 63-A.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

Mr. Carson was principal of a high school connected with Wheelers Field, Tripoli, Libya from September 1, 1954 to June 18, 1955. Credit for this should be given toward his retirement benefit under chapter 63-A.
