AN ACT Authorizing Charles H. Wade to Construct Bridge Between Reed Island and Town of Boothbay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Charles H. Wade authorized to construct bridge. Charles H. Wade and his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are authorized and empowered to construct and maintain a bridge or fill over tidewater between Reed Island, so called, and the shore of Boothbay Shores, in the Town of Boothbay, County of Lincoln. Construction of such bridge or fill shall be commenced within 2 years after the effective date of this act.
