IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Compensation for Legislators During Special Sessions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 10, § 2, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 2 of chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘When an extra session is called by the Governor, the members of the Senate and House of Representatives shall each be paid ~~\$10~~ \$20 for every day’s attendance, and mileage as aforesaid.’

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall become effective on the first Wednesday of January, 1963.
