IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Taking of Smelts in Crooked River and Songo River, Cumberland County.

Resolves, 1955, c. 104, amended. Resolved: That the 2nd sentence of the 12th paragraph of that part designated "Cumberland County" of chapter 104 of the Resolves of 1955, as amended by chapter 64 of the Resolves of 1957, be further amended to read as follows:

'All tributaries closed to the taking of smelts, except the Crooked River and Songo River.'
