SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 53, L. D. 94, Bill, "An Act Relating to Travel Allowance for Members of the Legislature."

Amend said Bill in the title by inserting after the word "Travel" the words 'and Expense'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out the word "sentence" in the first line and inserting in place thereof the word 'paragraph'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out the single quotation mark at the end and inserting in place thereof the following: "He is entitled to mileage on the first day of the session, and such amounts of his salary and expense allowance and at such times as the Legislature may determine during the session, and the balance at the end thereof. He shall also be entitled to an expense allowance of \$5 per day for every day's attendance. Two dollars shall be deducted from the pay of every member for each day that he is absent from his duties, without being excused by the house to which he belongs."
