AN ACT Relating to Travel Allowance for Members of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 10, § 2, amended. The first sentence of section 2 of chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 373 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives shall receive \$1,600 for the regular session of the Legislature, and shall be paid for travel at each legislative session once each week at the rate of ~~5e~~ 7c per mile to and from his place of abode, the mileage to be determined by the most reasonable direct route.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect on the first Wednesday of January, 1963.
