RESOLVE, in Favor of R. E. Hopkins of Hampden.

R. E. Hopkins; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,000 to be paid to R. E. Hopkins, of Hampden, as a full and final settlement against the State for damage to his driveway and lawn caused by the rise in the elevation of the highway in front of his home.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The rise in the elevation of the highway in front of Mr. Hopkins' home has made the driveway a source of danger and his lawn is a detriment to the value of his home. To make the driveway a safe exit to the highway and to repair the lawn will cost at least \$1,000. Mr. Hopkins is 80 years of age.
