RESOLVE, Authorizing State Highway Commission to Study Desirability of a Bridge Across the Androscoggin River.

Bridge across Androscoggin River; study authorized. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission be authorized and directed to make a study of the need and cost of a highway bridge across the Androscoggin River between the Cities of Lewiston and Auburn, in the County of Androscoggin, with necessary highway approaches thereto; and be it further

Resolved: That the commission shall report the results of their study at the next regular session of the Legislature.
