Committee Amendment "A" to H.P. 88, L.D. 128, Bill "An Act Relating to Use of Names by Corporations Organized Under the General Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out the second paragraph after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

'Sec. 10-A. Prior and exclusive use of names.

No corporation organizing under this chapter shall

assume, adopt or use the name of a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Maine, or

a name so nearly resembling the name of such corporation
as to be a colorable imitation thereof or calculated to
deceive any person.'
