IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing Free Fishing Licenses to Residents Seventy Years of Age.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 39, sub-§ XII-C, additional. Section 39 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding after subsection XII-B, a new subsection XII-C, to read as follows:

'XII-C. Residents 70 years of age. A license to fish shall be issued, if applied for, free of charge to every resident of the State who has reached the age of 70 years.'
