HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 92, L.D. 132, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Trapping Beaver in Organized and Unorganized Territory."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last 4 lines and inserting
in place thereof the following:

"as revised, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
'During such open season beaver may be trapped with the consent of
the landowner in unorganized territory, and with the written consent
of the landowner in organized territory.' "
