AN ACT Relating to Trapping Beaver in Organized and Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 119, amended. The first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 119 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed as follows: '~~During such open season beaver may be trapped without the consent of the landowner in unorganized territory, and only with the consent of the landowner in organized territory.~~'
