STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Term of Office of the City Clerk of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. VI, § 1, amended. The first sentence of section 1 of Article VI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as last amended by chapter 84 of the private and special laws of 1947, is further amended to read as follows:

'The city clerk shall be appointed by the mayor for a term of one year and shall not be removed except for cause; provided, however, that the city clerk holding office when this section amendment becomes effective shall be and continue in office as city clerk and shall not be removed except as provided herein.'

- Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall become effective upon a vacancy occurring by resignation or otherwise of the present city clerk of Lewiston.
- Sec. 3. Intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that this act shall in no way affect the present tenure of office of the present city clerk of Lewiston.
