STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Notification of Expiration of Motor Vehicle Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. Section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by inserting after the 4th paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

'The Secretary of State shall, at least 14 days prior to the anniversary of the date of birth of each license holder, mail first class to such license holder an application for renewal of license.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to carry out the purposes of this act.
