### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Increasing Inspection Fee for Sardines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 32, § 262, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 262 of chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 92 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'The inspection fee herein provided for may be increased by the commissioner after consultation with the Sardine Industry Advisory Board to an amount not to exceed 5e 8c per case, in the event the fee of 3c per case is not adequate to cover the cost of such inspection, but such increased fee shall be reasonable and shall cover as nearly as may be possible the cost of such inspection.'
