IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing on Big Pond, Dexter, Penobscot County.

Ice fishing on Big Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing that part of Lake Wassookeag in Dexter, Penobscot County, known as the Big Pond, being that part of said Lake Wassookeag lying westerly and southerly of the Guy H. Hall Memorial Bridge on the road leading from said Dexter to Sangerville, Route #23, so called, to ice fishing from the time ice forms in the fall until February 1st.
