**AN ACT** Requiring State and Municipal Consultation  
on Aid to Dependent Children.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 25, § 239, amended.** Section 239 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the 2nd sentence the following:

**'Before granting aid under sections 234 to 246, the department shall consult with the overseers of the poor or the department of public welfare of the municipality of residence as to the applicant's need for aid for the dependent child for whom the grant is requested.'**
